ASL Linguistics *ONLINE* a Modular Approach

For those who are interested in taking an ASL Linguistics course online, here's your chance! Invest an hour a day for two weeks and you can earn CEUs! This online training opportunity offers four modules, each one requiring 12 hours of online readings, peer discussions, plus an exit exam. With ASL Linguistics online, you can plan your coursework around your busy life and go to class when it fits your schedule.

Each module will address one of the basic components of linguistic study: Phonology – the building blocks of language, Morphology – the symbols formed, Syntax – building sentences, and Sociolinguistics – language and culture. Through the comparative linguistic analysis of ASL and English the course will help to strengthen the bridge interpreters need to build between these two very different languages.

It is strongly recommended that the modules be taken in sequence. Many concepts are introduced in the early modules and then expanded upon in later modules. Internet access and email are required to complete all modules. Prerequisite: American Sign Language III or equivalent skill. Instructor Roxanne Norway-White is a veteran interpreter of 30 years; she has been an instructor/mentor for the Interpreter Preparation Program at NCCC since 1981.
